My Pony Racing Season 2018 - Competition Terms and Conditions

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. By entering this competition, all participants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions in full. All entry instructions form part of these terms and conditions.
- 1.2. The competition is open to residents of the UK (excl. Northern Ireland) aged between 9-16 years old (inclusive) at the date on which they enter the competition, excluding employees of the promoter, its group companies, its agents or anyone professionally connected with this competition and any member of their respective immediate families.
- 1.3. All entrants must secure the consent of a parent or guardian before entering the competition and may be required to provide their parents' contact details to verify such consent and claim any prize, if required by the promoter.
- 1.4. Entry opens at midday on 1st May 2018 and closes at 11.59pm on September 21st 2018. Entries received after this time and date will not be eligible to win a prize.
- 1.5. No purchase is necessary to enter the competition. However, in order to enter the competition you must provide the promoter with a Pony Racing Season diary as described in Clause 2.

2. ENTRY TO THE COMPETITION

- 2.2. Only one entry is permitted per person.

3. WINNERS

- 3.1. Two winners will be selected by the Industry, People and Development Department of the BHA from all eligible entries on September 28 2018. Winners will be selected from 138cm Competitors and 148cm Competitors.
- 3.2. Winners will be notified by email and will be asked to confirm their details for delivery of the prize.

4. THE PRIZES

- 4.1. The prizes

148cm Competitors – One winner receives a careersinracing branded exercise saddle

5. CONDITIONS
