The Area Awards are open to those residing in the Devon & Cornwall Area. Points Trophies. Points will be taken from the best eight results. **The Synderborough Farm "Rising Stars" Trophy** will go to the pony / rider combination who accumulates the highest number of points throughout the season.

The "Allerton Organics Shield" will go to the combination with the highest points throughout the season in the opposite height category to the above.

The "Greatrex" Trophies will be presented to the 2nd & 3rd highest point scoring combinations throughout the season.

The "Alan Walter Horse Transport" Trophy will be awarded to the rider who has shown the most promise throughout the season (i.e. the rider who is deemed to have improved the most and also been the most helpful on racedays).
